Stroke / Stableford Competitions

Every time you play golf (except for a day of Par) all golfers are asked to mark their card with **both their stroke and stableford scores**. (Please also total and check the stableford score) There are several jolly good reasons for this.

- Golflink requires your stableford score even if the competition of the day was stroke.
- You will also then be included in the Super Nine competition.
- The results can then be finalised much quicker and with much less chance of mistakes.

It is also easier for the golfer to write in the stableford scores as you mark the card than to expect Ashley, Gordon or Bill to do it for as many as half the playing group. It is very time consuming task.

Bend your knees- save your back!

Spring has sprung, so there's a fair chance that you'll be putting in some long hours in the garden in the next few weeks, if you haven't already. Remember, gardening can be a vigorous activity performed over sustained periods. In this way it is akin to sport and many of the same principals apply.

Sport is all about safety and performance.....so is gardening.

Before you start thinking about what to plant and where, make sure you're thinking safety, as well.

Gardening safely

Begin your gardening session with a few stretches to warm up the muscles and joints you will be using to prevent injury and reduce soreness at the end of the day.

Make sure the area in which you are working is free of obstacles such as gardening tools, bags and seedling trays to prevent slips and falls.

Vary your activities so that you are not in the one position for more than 30 minutes at a time.

When doing tasks at ground level, like weeding or planting, kneel rather than bend from the waist.

Where possible, keep one hand on the ground for support as you lean forward.

If your garden beds are wired up, step into the bed to work rather than lean in from the edge.
