

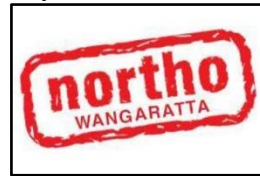


Jubilee Jottings

Greens Report

Irrigation

Irrigation pump 1 has been replaced with a new unit, testing will happen this week. The river pump has been on 24/7 for the last week to top up dam.

Tees

Tees are very dry, watering will start this week.

Greens

Greens are in excellent condition ready for the Renovations this Wednesday.

Pathways

Stones have been mortared in on the left side of the 1st, the other side will be done in a couple of weeks time. The base has been done on the 2nd pathway, we will monitor it over next few months. It may not require any concrete edges.

Fairways

By the end of this week all the course will be sprayed for broadleaf weeds & the fairways will be sprayed with Monument in early November

Clay mounds have been formed and corings from the greens will be spread over this week.

Machinery

Fertiliser spreader was purchased last Monday and granular fertiliser ordered for fairways. We also have trialled using fine dry sand on the greens. This is a huge bonus for us. Greens can be dusted with sand regularly with no interruption to play.
