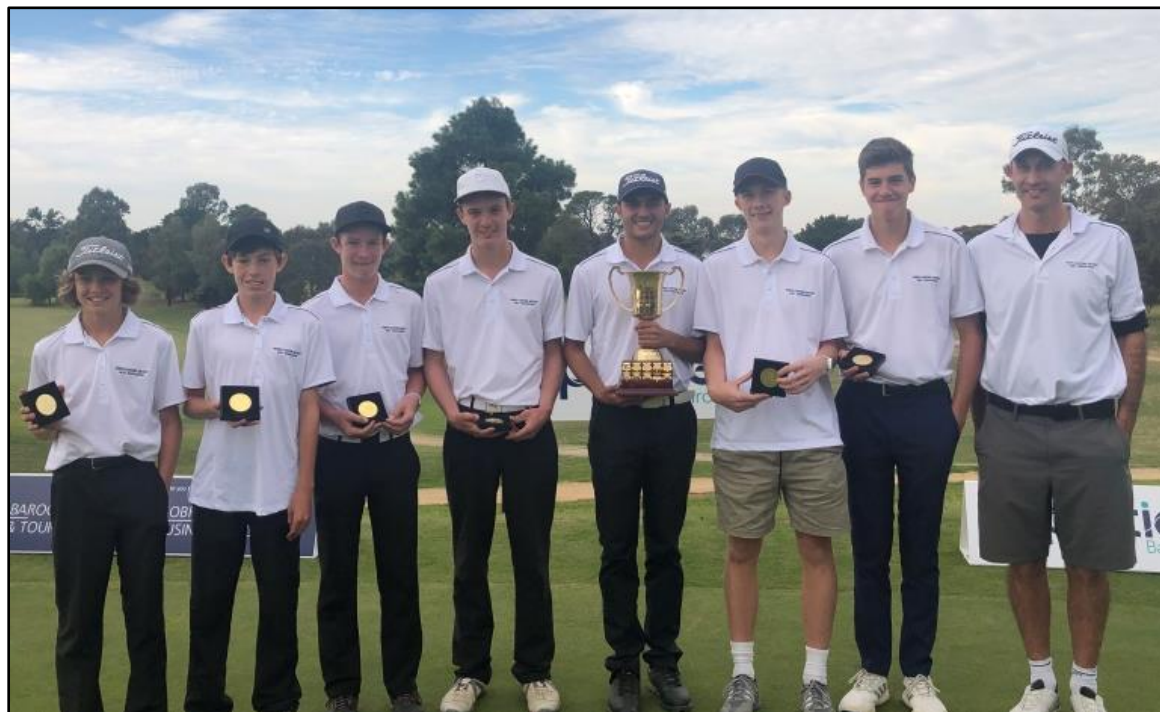

Irrigation:

The 1st fairway mounds are progressing ready for couch sprigging in the spring,

There is no runoff into the dam, as yet.

Greens:

The greens are being lightly dusted with sand fortnightly to help keep a smooth surface.

Pathways:

The pathways on the 8th and 9th haven't gone as well as planned. Heavy rain the day after has caused a lot of soft areas. Hopefully they dry out this week. No more pathways until the weather improves.

Tees and Surrounds:

Couch on the tees is going dormant for the winter. Please repair your divots with sand and level off.

Fairways:

The couch is going into dormancy.

Our changeover from liquid to granular fertilizer was a great success.

Good growth with the first cut improving with the tree root cutting.

Another 6, part fairways, will be sprigged in late spring this year.
