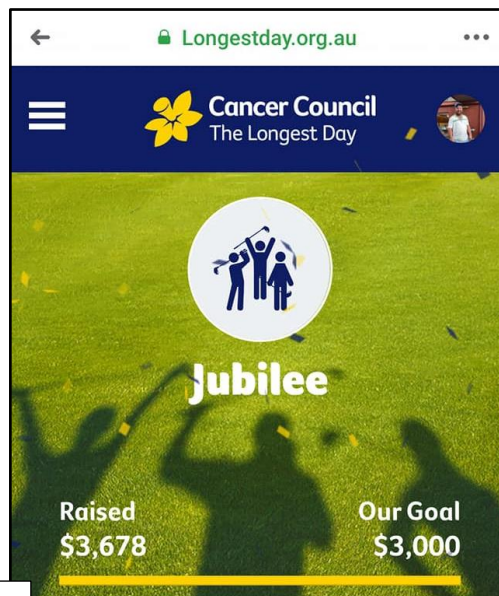
~ The Longest Day ~

As we are still working through these COVID19 times there has been some small changes to the way we go about nominating each week. Until everything returns to normal, we will have someone in the office to collect your money and they will also take your name and write it on the sheet. There be no cards handed out or collected after the game. Draw will be done by the Vets Captain and tees allocated to start. Nominations will start at 8:00am and play will commence at 8:30am. There will be no nearest the pins until further notice. On completion of your round scores for both front and back nines plus total score are to be read out to the collecting official in the club rooms. Please note that masks must be worn at all times in the club rooms unless you are eating or drinking.

Going forward from 25/1/2021 it has been advised that the Jubilee Vets will be conducted as above for nominations on all Mondays except for the Monday that have a NEDVGA event. This is usually the fourth Monday each month. For those that do not go away with the NEDVGA normal time sheet will be available from Ashley in the Pro shop on that day.

Victorian Four-Ball

The Vic Four-Ball championship is open to all golfers who are members of affiliated clubs and have a handicap. The championship involves men's, women's and mixed sections and is played in two parts: 18-hole qualifying events and a 36-hole state final.

For metropolitan qualifiers, pairs will nominate their three preferred venues through the online registration process and Golf Australia will endeavour to allocate pairs according to preference as closely as possible.

Pairs will again be able to enter as many regional qualifiers as they wish with the field decided by entries as received.

Eligibility: Males with a handicap below 35.4 and females with a handicap below 45.4

Entry Fee: \$90 per pair for each regional qualifier / \$70 per pair for host club members at all regional qualifiers (all inc. GST)

The Four-ball entries are done online.

The closing date for entries is 5th Feb 2021 at 9.00am or when the field is full.

There are currently 21 pairs entered.

Date of Jubilee GC Qualifier: 14th February.
