## Snippets from "past minutes of meetings" that remind us of our club's history.

**June 1945.** After the war the clubhouse was repainted and the club had 33 members, 39 Associates and 1 Junior.

**June 1956.** Mr E. Parsons, not seeking to nominate for President after serving in that capacity for 17 years was unanimously voted in as the first Life Member of JGC. It was doubtful the club would have survived the war years but for Mr Parsons.

**March 1962.** AGM: Discussion of a piece of land available for purchase for a new site for the club. 149 Acres – excellent soil with a 3 bedroom house for use as a clubhouse, colossal scenery, ample water, good dirt road six miles from Wangaratta for 5500 pound.

**August 1979.** A Liquor licence was granted to JGC. Beer available was Carlton Draught, Courage and Light.
