

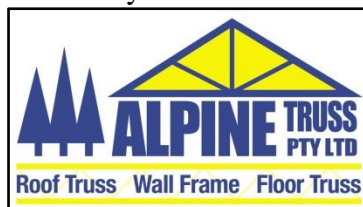

Guide to Golf Etiquette

Avoid standing on someone's line

Other than talking through someone's shot, when it comes to distractions, this is probably the biggest – and most annoying. Stepping on someone's putting line means your spikes can leave little indents in the greens, which can upset the line of the ball and derail the putt. Being aware of and walking around people's lines is also important when you are walking between holes. Also be careful to steer clear of people's through lines (where the ball will go if they miss a shot).

White pegs mean the area to the left is Abnormal Ground Conditions (i.e. GUR)

Your Options:

1

Take your shot from where the ball lies

(It is optional GUR)

OR

2

The nearest point of complete relief from the GUR

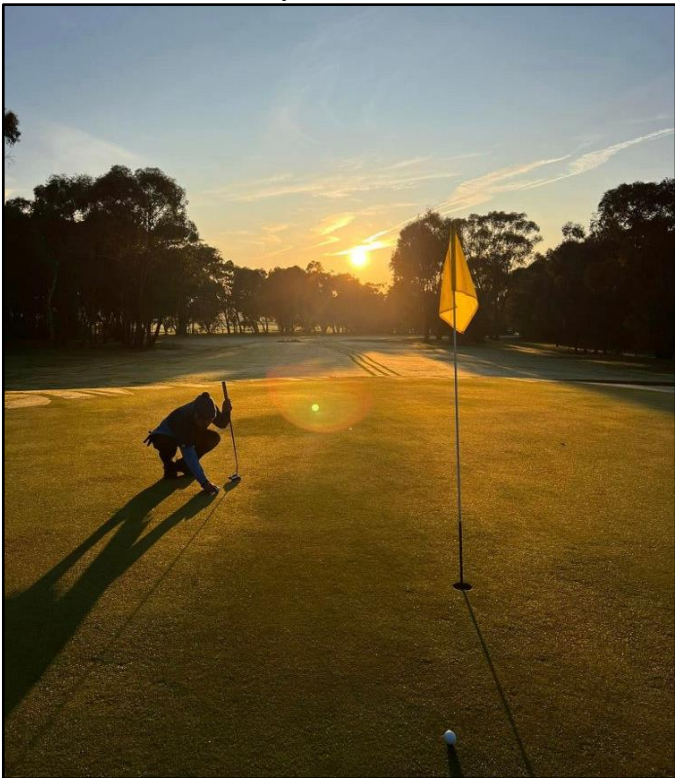

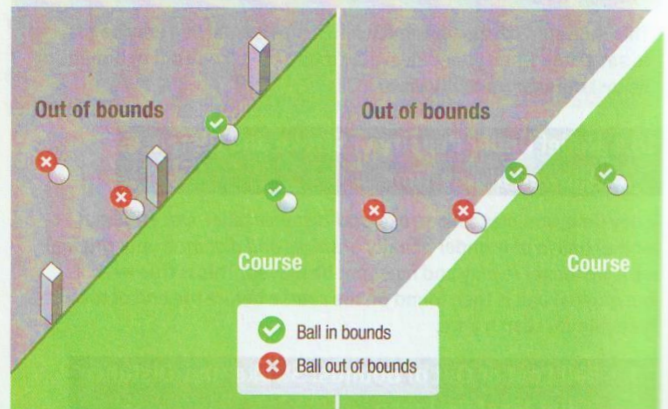
OOB on the 17th

The new OOB fence along right side of the 17th has been installed in August. It is post and rail to match the existing section near the front gate.

Members are reminded of our OOB rule: Play your next shot from where the previous shot was made. The ball is out if the entire ball is behind the front of the posts. (one penalty stroke)

DIAGRAM 18.2a: WHEN BALL IS OUT OF BOUNDS

A ball is out of bounds only when all of it is outside the boundary edge of the course. The diagrams provide examples of when a ball is in bounds and out of bounds.



The boundary edge is defined by the line between the course-side points of the stakes at ground level, and the stakes are out of bounds.

The boundary edge is the course-side edge of the line, and the line itself is out of bounds.

18.2b What to Do When Your Ball Is Lost or Out of Bounds

If your ball is *lost* or *out of bounds*, you must take *stroke-and-distance* relief by adding **one penalty stroke** and playing a ball from where the previous *stroke* was made (see Rule 14.6).
