#### Course staff have right of way at all times

Golfers MUST WAIT AND GIVE WAY to Ground Staff, mowers or maintenance vehicles to pass, or be safely out of range, before playing a stroke unless they have acknowledged you and called you up. If a green is being worked on and the flagstick is not in the hole, players are not to hit to the green until it is replaced. Remember, this is the workplace of our Ground Staff and all employees should be shown respect.
