

Be sure to always consult the noticeboard outside the Pro Shop for Temporary Local Rules for situations which occur and are temporarily present on the golf course such as: —

- -Ground Under Repair
- -Areas of Course Maintenance Works
- -Fallen Trees
- -Burst Pipe
- -Damage to the Course
- -Wheel Marks made by Course Equipment
- -Aeration Holes
- -Embedded Ball Through the Green
- -Preferred Lies or Tee-Up due to extremely wet/muddy conditions
- -Temporary Obstructions
